Barwon Water Hero Program

At Marshalltown Road Kindergarten, we're taking part in the Barwon Water Hero program. The program teaches children about water and healthy habits through play, hands-on activities and stories, covering topics like water saving, hydration and looking after our local waterways.

Children take on the Water Hero pledge, committing to drink water every day and do the right thing with water at kindergarten and at home.

Paper-making and recycling station

In our service the children learn how to make their own paper from waster paper, and they reuse it for arts, crafts and writing.



Waste sorting

We sort our waste into five bins: compost, reuse, recycling, soft plastics and landfill. Children take an active role in sorting each day, learning why some things break down, some things get a second life and some things simply can't be reused. It's a hands-on way to see how small daily choices add up to looking after our environment.

Learning about plants

The children have grown vegetables and flowers from seed, watching them sprout, grow and flower over the term. The vegetables are shared with families to take home and enjoy. Along the way, children have noticed the insects visiting our garden, and started to understand how plants and creatures depend on each other in our environment.
